School fees cover tuition, books, and food costs. These fees cover only a portion of the cost of the religious school. KI as a congregation supports KIvunim financially because the Jewish education of our children is a top priority for our community.

All families are encouraged to be members of KI.
A minimum payment of one-third of the school fees is due by Sunday, September 7. Any tuition balance from last year must also be paid by this date. Full payment for this school year must be submitted by Sunday, January 11, 2023.
