Dear Parents,

A founding principle at KI is that a lack of financial resources should never prevent anyone from being able to participate fully in exploring their Judaism at KI. The Appel Fund is a scholarship fund which provides assistance to families with less financial means so that they may send their children to Kivunim School. Funds are donated by congregation members throughout the year in memory of Selma and Jonathan Appel.

If paying tuition for your child(ren) to attend Kivunim produces an undue financial hardship for your family, we encourage you to contact the School Director at 882-0049 and let her know that you would like to apply for a scholarship for your child(ren). She will discuss your needs with you and will then grant partial or full scholarships based on your financial needs and the amount of money available in the Fund. Please do not be shy about applying for a scholarship if the need is there. Providing religious education to our children is our most important goal at KI and we want your child to participate with us.

Finally, for those with more than adequate financial means, we encourage you to make a donation to the Fund during Kivunim School registration (or at any other time of the year) so that we can continue to provide financial assistance to families as needed.
